### SCENIC SANGRE DE CRISTO MOUNTAINS

**Sunday September 19, 2010**

**9:00am:** Meet at the Rest Stop at I-25 and Hwy 165. Will leave promptly at 9am. Will travel together to trailhead.

**10:00am :** Trail Ride begins at: [Huerfano SWA/State Wildlife Area and Campground.](#)

Bring Rain Gear and appropriate tack; Sunscreen, etc. Also bring a lunch and something to drink. The horses can drink from the river and there are public restrooms in the camp ground.

We can go on a 6 mile ride up and back, or go further if some people would like. There will be 2 water crossings and some rock at the beginning of the trail. The Aspens should be changing color and it will be very scenic.

**Directions:** Take I-25 south to exit 56 .Go West to Hwy 69. Then take a right and Go to the town of Gardner. As you leave Gardner take the first left; Co Rd 550. Co Rd 550 turns into Co Rd 580. Stay to the left at the "Y"; (if you go right you will Go to Mosca Pass). About 1 mile past the "Y" you will see the camp ground on the left. From Hwy 69 the campground is about 15 miles West. Paved for about Half the distance and real good gravel road for the remainder.
