RCC SADDLE CLUB NEW INSURANCE RULES FOR 2009 INSURANCE ALERT!!!

RCC SADDLE CLUB, Inc. is a private non profit club. The Arena and surrounding acres are privately owned by the Club. Members are allowed to use the facilities whenever there is not a planned event going on. Anyone who is not a current member must sign a Liability Waiver Form when coming onto the private club property. Joining as a Member is highly recommended and encouraged. Anyone brought to an Event as a guest will have to sign a liability waiver. Membership forms and Liability forms are in a box at the snack bar.

Any Member wanting to schedule an "Event" must run the plans through the Board for approval. The Club's Insurance plan retains rights to review Events. They may be covered or not. Fees will apply in some cases. New "no trespass" signs are on order and will be put up at the Arena this Spring to remind anyone coming onto the grounds that the arena and surrounding acreage is private property.

Discussion: Linda will check with Insurance company for verbage on signs.
