RCC Saddle Club

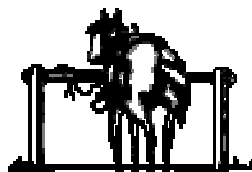
Once again it's time for all RCC members (18 and younger) to sign-up for Royalty.

Ropin is a registered Pinto, a real smooth ride & can go anywhere and just about do anything. Rode for a week in the Black Hills this spring 6hrs/day 5 days/week just for fun. Goes in the mountains, works cattle, not afraid of ropes, traffic safe, no spook or buck and doesn't have to be ridden 24/7 to stay that way. I'd put just about any skill level on him and feel confident that he'd take care of them. 15.1-2h. Works off leg cues- picks up leads, sidepasses, neck reins & has a nice stop. Stands well for farrier, clipping, bathing, shots, worming (UTD on both and recent teeth floating too). Loads himself into a trailer, ground ties, has good hard feet (currently shod) & fine to catch. He does prefer the company of other horses, but rides out alone/back perfectly fine. Our 12 yr old daughter (and other saddle club kids & a neighbor) started riding him this summer & had a blast as he does what you tell him & is safe every time. This horse has a TON of heart. If he can't do it, he'll die trying, so you better stop him first! Also did Team Sorting w/ the kids (see video) this summer. Foaled 5/27/95 in Pueblo- papers in hand. Use him for casual trails, occasional playdays, cow sorting or penning, pony out your mules w/ elk, or just go down the road. He just wouldn't be a competitive gymkana/barrel/pole horse, as he can't handle 5 days a week in tight circles- you'll make his shoulder sore. Since my daughter wants a barrel/pole horse, he just doesn't work here. He loves his tummy rubbed, so come and take a look and let's talk! \$1,500.00. Jennifer Stalder. 719-676-2908.
